

Athens Academy Club Information and FAQs

What kind of clubs are offered at Athens Academy?

At Athens Academy, clubs and other student organizations offer students opportunities for leadership and a chance to discover and develop their personal interests. Each year students lead more than 20 different clubs at Athens Academy which represent diverse interests of the current student body; these clubs evolve through the years and with student interest.

What if I want to start a club?

The list of clubs can be quite extensive from year to year. If a student does not find what he or she is looking for in our club program, he or she is welcome to start a new organization. The Upper School faculty is excited to help students initiate new clubs and will work with them throughout the school year to ensure success. **If you are interested in starting a new club, see the Upper School Deans of Student Life to register your club.**

Do I need a Faculty Advisor for my club?

Yes. Faculty sponsors guide and offer support to student club leaders to organize fundraisers, social and academic events, and even competitions depending on the focus of the club or organization. They might also help students reach out to the community through student organized field trips.

Many of our clubs are student proposed, meaning the students themselves organize, recruit members, and plan agendas.

How do I find out what clubs are available?

At the start of each year, most clubs are represented at the annual Club and Service Fair. Clubs will have information about their clubs and where you can go to sign up for the clubs you are most interested.

What do we do if we want to raise money for our club?

If you want to hold a fundraiser, you will need to complete the Community Service Board Grant Application.

How often do clubs meet?

Regular club meetings are crucial to club success. Meeting times are available every Monday during Student Life time from 10:25-10:55 am. Meeting schedules are created by the club leader and faculty advisor.
